

WHY IT MATTERS

Children, parents and carers have shared they do not feel heard at times

Many adults across the borough have literacy difficulties



Contacting school can be a challenge and at times feel like you are going round in circles There is a disconnect for parents and carers during transition to secondary education that can leave parents feeling lost.

MHAT HAVE ME DONES

- Researched, shared and gathered best practice information.
- Heard from a family support worker Lauren Carney Covering 4 Primary schools in the 1s6 area
- MET WITH CENTRE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE TO DISCUSS LOST BOYS AND A GROWING TREND OF ANTI EDUCATION AMONGST THEM
- SWAPPED IDEAS ACROSS TRUSTS AND GATHERED TOOLS NOT USED PREVIOUSLY TO TRY
- GAVE CYP OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE THEIR EXPERIENCES AND SPEAK TO PROFESSIONALS ABOUT LOCAL CHALLENGES SUCH AS CRIME, VIOLENCE POVERTY AND DRUGS
- Funded large scale program in secondary schools supporting 30 pupils with Anglo America

- CREATED A SHARED COMMUNITY SPACE WITHIN THE SCHOOL
 IN DORMANSTOWN TO TRIAL SPACES TO SHARE AND INFORM,
 EDUCATE AND EMPOWER PARENTS AND CARERS
- LOOKED INTO INFORMATION SHARED AS TO WHY CHILDREN DO NOT ATTEND, LOOKING FOR WAYS TO ADDRESS SOLUTIONS ACROSS THE UK AND WIDER.
- Breakfast Clubs, farm shops, opportunities to refer into supportive programs, access to appointments
- Addressed statistics highlighted from adult literacy regarding the 55000 adults across our borough with reading age of 9 years and under
